



## **USCG CEU Juneau Travel Plan to St Paul Island**

**Project:** PNS 14768188 Repair Fire Damage LORSTA St Paul & 15687435 Pre Proposal Site Visit

Planned Travel Date: 10/06/2020

Number of Travelers: 14 persons + aircraft personnel.

Essential Travel Government Services Travel Protection Plans (EO 20-96: Section 3 (a) (4))

### Elements of the Plan

- (1) USCG intends that the personnel travel to St. Paul Island shall not interact with any members/residence to St. Paul Island. They shall stay separate, go from the Airport to the LORSTA and fly out on the plane that shall wait for the travelers on the Tarmac. Intent is to use the Quarantine Bus to travel between Airport and LORSTA.
- (2) The planes will stay on the tarmac to fly the travelers out. Anticipated 5 hours on the ground.
- (3) All travelers agree to submit to health screening at St. Paul Island, if requested.
- (4) All travelers agree to self-quarantine for 14 days and not interact with any residences of St. Paul Island.
- (5) All travelers agree they will not enter residences in St. Paul Island.
- (6) All travelers agree they will not enter any public spaces in St. Paul Island. This includes but not limited to Post Office, Public/City Offices, Grocery stores, gas station or community centers.
- (7) All travelers agree to wear PPE (IE cloth face masks) during their time at St. Paul Island. Travelers will bring their own food and water in their personal gear for the duration of the trip.
- (8) All travelers agree to maintain social distancing, minimum of 6 feet way, from any persons outside their household whenever possible.
- (9) LORSTA Facility will be unlocked by the travelers via door code. No contact with Facility Care Takers and travelers shall occur.
- (10) All travelers shall have COVID 19 Rapid Tests before travel to Island and provide test results to the City of St. Paul Island Prior to travel.
- (11) All travelers shall provide COVID 19 travel form #10 to the City of St. Paul Island prior to travel.

Number of Travelers: 14 persons + aircraft personnel.

### Elements of the Plan

- (1) USCG intends that the personnel travel to St. Paul Island shall not interact with any members/residence to St. Paul Island. - (3) All travelers agree to submit to health screening at St. Paul Island, if requested.
- (4) All travelers agree not to interact with any residents of St. Paul Island.
- (5) All travelers agree they will not enter residences in St. Paul Island.
- (6) All travelers agree they will not enter any public spaces in St. Paul Island. This includes but not limited to Post Office, Public/City Offices, Grocery stores, gas station or community centers.
- (7) All travelers agree to wear PPE (IE cloth face masks) during their time at St. Paul Island. Travelers will bring their own food and water in their personal gear for the duration of the trip.
- (8) All travelers agree to maintain social distancing, minimum of 6 feet way, from any persons outside their household whenever possible.
- (9) Plan to have LORSTA Facility Care Takers unlock the facility in the morning prior to Aircraft arrival and then lock the facility after visitors depart. No contact with Facility Care Takers and travelers shall occur.
- (10) All travelers shall have COVID 19 Tests before travel to Island and provide test results to the City of St. Paul Island prior to travel. Per discussion between Brian Goettler, USCG and Mr. Zavadil, St. Paul City Manager on 9/15/2020, rapid test results are acceptable.
- (11) All travelers shall provide COVID 19 travel form #10 to the City of St. Paul Island prior to travel.
