LOCAL CASE: 1 Confirmed Case

VACCINATION STATUS:

- 177 Residents Fully Vaccinated
- 20 Residents with 1 Dose
- 154 Non-residents with 1 Dose

The Saint Paul Health Center is ordering additional COVID vaccine supplies for interested residents.

TEST PERFORMED

- 516 Tests performed, Anchorage (*as of 3/12/21*)
- 156 Tests performed, Saint Paul Island (*as of 3/12/21*)

TESTING SITE

The Saint Paul Health Center established a drive-up COVID-19 testing location in a tent outside the health center; this is open to anyone in the community.

“HUNKER DOWN”: Today the City Council of the City of Saint Paul approved Emergency Ordinance 21-93 Proclamation of Emergency "Hunker Down" to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout Saint Paul Island. The “hunker down” will begin April 1, 2021 at 6:00 pm and end on April 15, 2021 at 6:00 pm. This ordinance extended Emergency Ordinance 21-92 for an additional 30 days. This was not an easy decision but ultimately the safest decision for our community.
