SUBJECT: COVID-19

LOCAL RISK FACTOR: Medium High

POSITIVE COIVD-19 CASE: Today the Saint Paul Island Unified Command was informed that two essential workers tested positive for COVID-19 on Friday, January 7, 2022, and three essential workers tested positive for COVID-19 on Monday, January 10, 2022. The individual will isolate until and they complete a 10-day isolation.

ACTIONS TO TAKE to ensure the safety of the community:

• The positive individuals will isolate in quarantine housing for 10 days.

GET TESTED IF YOU ARE SICK: If are feeling ill or sick no matter how minor the symptoms get tested for COVID-19. Contact the Saint Paul Health Center during normal business hours to arrange to get tested. Additionally, if you are feeling sick stay home from school or work.

GET VACCIANTED AND BOOSTED: To protect yourself and others against COIVD-19 if eligible get vaccinated and boosted.
