**SUBJECT:** COVID-19

**LOCAL RISK FACTOR:** Medium High

**POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE:** Today the Saint Paul Island Unified Command was informed that two essential workers tested positive for COVID-19 on Friday, January 7, 2022, and three essential workers tested positive for COVID-19 on Monday, January 10, 2022. The individual will isolate until and they complete a 10-day isolation.

**ACTIONS TO TAKE** to ensure the safety of the community:

- The positive individuals will isolate in quarantine housing for 10 days.

**GET TESTED IF YOU ARE SICK:** If are feeling ill or sick no matter how minor the symptoms get tested for COVID-19. Contact the Saint Paul Health Center during normal business hours to arrange to get tested. Additionally, if you are feeling sick stay home from school or work.

**GET VACCINATED AND BOOSTED:** To protect yourself and others against COVID-19 if eligible get vaccinated and boosted.
