SUBJECT: COVID-19

LOCAL RISK FACTOR: Medium High

POSITIVE COVID-19 CASE: Yesterday the Saint Paul Island Unified Command was informed that one essential worker tested positive for COVID-19 on Tuesday, January 11, 2022, The individual will isolate until and they will complete a 10-day isolation.

ACTIONS TO TAKE to ensure the safety of the community:

- The positive individual will isolate in quarantine housing for 10 days.

GET TESTED IF YOU ARE SICK: If are feeling ill or sick no matter how minor the symptoms get tested for COVID-19. Contact the Saint Paul Health Center during normal business hours to arrange to get tested. Additionally, if you are feeling sick stay home from school or work.

GET VACCINATED AND BOOSTED: To protect yourself and others against COVID-19 if eligible get vaccinated and boosted.
