**SUBJECT:** COVID-19

#### **LOCAL RISK FACTOR: MEDIUM-HIGH**

**POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES:** The City of Saint Paul is pleased to report no new cases of COVID-19 have been reported to the City since June 25, 2022.

**TOTAL POSITIVE CASES TO DATE:** Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic Saint Paul Island has had 160 individuals that have tested positive for COVID-19.

**ACTIVE POSITIVE CASES:** As of today, Saint Paul Island has 10 active COVID-19 cases.

**COVID-19 PREVENTIVE MEASURES:** Wash Your Hands, Wear a Mask in Indoor Public Spaces, Watch For Symptoms, Stay Health, Vaccinate.

**GET TESTED IF YOU ARE SICK:** If are feeling ill or sick no matter how minor the symptoms get tested for COVID-19. Contact the Saint Paul Health Center during normal business hours to arrange to get tested. Additionally, if you are feeling sick stay home from school or work.

**GET VACCINATED AND BOOSTED:** To protect yourself and others against COVID-19 if eligible get vaccinated and boosted.
